


























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Instructions: Take one “BIRDO” sheet and a dry erase marker. There are 5 versions to choose from. If you have a group playing together, then be sure to take different versions! Look for items on the sheet and mark off each box as you find the item. The middle space, the Kellogg Bird Sanctuary Logo, is a free space. The goal is to connect 5 boxes in any direction (i.e across, vertical, diagonal). If more than one participant, the first to connect 5 boxes in a row wins!

Things you may see: resident neck-banded Trumpeter Swans, Canada Geese, Robins, Frogs, wild Trumpeter Swans, Woodpeckers, a Memorial Bench, Lake Loop signs, Sparrows, Chipmunks, our resident Mandarin Duck, resident Bobwhites, our resident Black Swan, Blue Jays, fallen Chestnuts, Chickadees, feathers, Wood Ducks, Birch Trees, Squirrels, Fish, resident neck-banded Mute Swans, pinecones, Cardinals
